



# Understanding the Treaty of Waitangi

## - A special workshop invitation to staff in small workplaces with Tangata Tiriti - Treaty People

Understanding the Treaty of Waitangi is vital for all professionals and service providers in Aotearoa New Zealand.

This full day workshop is specially designed as a refresher for staff in small workplaces to enable you to meet your quality standards. It aims to:

- refresh staff knowledge in light of ongoing advances in understanding Māori-Pākehā relationships.
- provide recent updates from Waitangi Tribunal hearings about Te Tiriti and He Wakaputanga (the Declaration of Independence).
- help build relationships with tangata whenua Māori.
- support staff efforts towards biculturalism.
- encourage workplaces in their strategic planning.

The workshop is appropriate for those with little or no knowledge of the treaty, and also for those wanting to update their professional training.

The workshop is popular with social and health services, local bodies and community organisations as a way of bringing together staff with diverse knowledge levels about the Treaty. Workshop activities are based on *Tangata Tiriti-Treaty People: An interactive workbook on the Treaty of Waitangi* (2006).

Dr. Ingrid Huygens is national coordinator of the Tangata Tiriti-Treaty People project, and has been a Treaty educator since 1989. Ingrid offers workshops around the country to DHBs, local authorities, community organisations and commercial enterprises and educational institutions. She completed her PhD at the University of Waikato on how New Zealanders respond to learning about the treaty (*Processes of Pākehā change in response to the Treaty of Waitangi*, 2007). She is a registered community psychologist.
